Accommodation Options

We suggest that people arrive in Cambridge during the day on Thursday 27th October, as the conference will begin with a panel and reception that evening.

Conference sessions on Saturday 29th October will take place at the British Museum in London, with a coach departing Cambridge at 7am. It may be possible to arrange accommodation in London that night. Alternatively, there will be a return coach to Cambridge at 6pm, so it may be more economical to return to Cambridge that night.

There are a range of accommodation options near the McDonald Institute (postcode CB2 3DZ). The Travelodge on the Newmarket Road is an affordably but basic option with good travel connections to central Cambridge. Most accommodation options can be found at:
